The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bic wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid fo supply of goods. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which wo be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices receiv Bid / RA process.
- 6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all with any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. A सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साध सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी पंजीकृत हो।बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन व अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।
